OADDL is conducting Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI) testing as per

FEDERAL ORDER, effective Monday, April 29, 2024

Milk from all <u>lactating dairy cattle</u> MUST be tested for HPAI within 7 days prior to interstate (between states) movement. OADDL will also test milk from lactating cows in the following situations:

- Dairy cattle suspected of disease due to being sick (must have a FADI number from the State Vet's Office)
- 2. Producers interested in the disease status of their apparently healthy animals
- 3. Samples taken from other animals in dairies associated with the HPAI disease event

The USDA will pay for the testing.

Please, use the following guidelines to submit samples to OADDL for testing under this federal order:

- 1. Complete OADDL submittal form.
- 2. Premise ID required.
- All four (4) quarters should be sampled and combined into a single leak proof container/tube (3-10ml/cow required).
- 4. For other animals on dairies associated with the disease event, submit nasal swabs.
- Ship samples in insulated shipping containers using overnight, trackable shipping methods with frozen gel packs.
